Maine Aging Population

Currently in Maine, **23%** of the population is age 60 and older, with projections of more than **30%** expected by 2030. In the EAAA service area, approximately **27 percent (68,296)** of the overall population is age 60 or older.

Our Numbers for 2020:

We distributed **27,815** Commodity Supplement Food Boxes to food insecure people across four counties.

We distributed **128,339** lbs pet food and basic supplies to low-income seniors through our Furry Friends Food Bank.

We delivered **188,859** meals to food insecure senior living at home through our Meals on Wheels Program

We answered **13,820** calls/contacts for information and assistance.

330 volunteers spent **21,299** hours giving back to the community.
